HANOI

It is impossible to find just one word to describe Hanoi – Vietnam’s capital regarding what this city has to offer to tourists. The enigmatic Hanoi, lies on western bank of the great Red River, has gone through over a thousand year of ups and downs which left behind a rich heritage of historical sites and cultural essence. Within the city center, visitors can explore on foot all of well-preserved colonial architectures, timeless pagodas and temples, munch on mouthwatering Hanoi street food, and blend in diverse crowd enjoying exciting nightlife. To maintain its classic charming appeal, Hanoi remains many remarkable Vietnamese traditional artistic performances such as Tuong plays or Water Puppet shows, giving foreign travelers glimpses to Vietnamese customs and spiritual life. With roads link to other main cities of Vietnam, international airports and national railways, Hanoi is, without a doubt, either an exquisite beginning or a delightful final destination of a journey discovering Vietnam.



HALONG BAY

Declared as UNESCO World Heritage Site twice for its universal value, Halong Bay has been justifiably included in every Vietnam travel itinerary ever. Halong Bay features more than 1600 islands, islets and karst pillars outcrop from the turquoise ocean, forming an incredible seascape that has “no equivalent sites in World Heritage list”. Spend a day or two on a cruise sails further to the emerald water, visitors can admire the glowing yet dreamy scenery like a mirage at either dusk or dawn. Aside from that, limestone caves with unique stalactites also created large number of mystical sites for travelers to uncover. Halong Bay with its pristine natural inherit and relaxing ambience is truly a gift from Mother Nature that should not be missed.





SAPA

Tourists often come to Sapa to get lost in the mist, exploring the majestic landscape of this mountainous region. Located 350 kilometers to the northwest from Hanoi, Sapa town conceals itself under the white haze amidst gigantic mountains. Sapa is decorated by various verdant and fertile rice terraces that provide a feast to the eyes. Home to Vietnam's highest peak - Fansipan, people visit Sapa bearing a desire of conquering this summit of Indochina. Not only blessed with splendid natural beauty, Sapa is also a cradle to many ethnic minority communities, mainly Hmong, Dao, Tay, Giay and Xa Pho who always give their warmest welcome to visitors to learn about their culture and customs.

HA GIANG

For adventurers who are looking for lesser-known area of Vietnam, Ha Giang should absolutely be added in your travel bucket list. Stretches along Vietnam-China border, Ha Giang is known for its rocky structure formed by enormous granite mountain and deep canyons. Though visiting Ha Giang requires a certain time and effort of driving, it is very worthwhile as the beauty of Ha Giang can only be felt along the way, it does not lie in a specific destination. Ha Giang is the definition of untouched nature, the authenticity is unbeatable. It shows not only from the pristine scenery but also from the lifestyle of local inhabitants. Villages are open to curious travelers to see the sights of hill tribe antique customs and beautiful handicrafts.

CAO BANG

The immensely wonderful land of Cao Bang located on a picturesque riverscape of Bang Giang river, a mountainous area borders with the neighboring country - China. This frontier area is mostly inhabited by ethnic minority people who have a pure way of life, creating several cultural experiences for anyone who come to visit. Non Nuoc Cao Bang Geopark and Ban Gioc Waterfall will definitely fill tourists with a sense of awe with their biodiversity and unique karst landscape. History buffs can visit Pac Bo Cave or Tran Hung Dao forest to find war relics in a serene ambience.

MAI CHAU

Set in Hoa Binh Province, 140 kilometers from Hanoi capital to the west, Mai Chau Valley has long been praised by nature lovers for its lush green mountainous grandeur. Looking down from a vantage point, Mai Chau Valley nestles between rolling hills and mountains carpeted in verdant forest, effortlessly blends in fertile infinite rice fields. Without the hustle and bustle, Mai Chau offers free and breezy atmosphere where you can spend your time cycling in blissful villages, wake up to birds singing, murmuring brooks and the sound of gentle wind rustling through bamboos and trees. A refreshing retreat in Mai Chau includes various activities from visiting the mysterious Chieu cave and Mo Luong cave to experiencing life of ethnic minorities in their stilt house.



NINH BINH

Often overlooked in favour of Halong Bay and Sapa, Ninh Binh is said to be a hidden gem of Northern Vietnam. Ninh Binh's karst limestone hills and towers spread all over the flat land, forming a magnificent landscape relatively similar to Halong Bay except it sets on land. Below the cliffs are beautiful river and rice paddies sprawling out across the vista like a sublime movie set. To explore Ninh Binh's natural gorgeousness, tourists can choose to go on a boat ride navigating their way through the desirable Tam Coc and Trang An, or go on an adventurous hike in Cuc Phuong National Park. Adding to Ninh Binh's cultural charm, Hoa Lu is also a historical landmark attracting tourists for its ancient history.



HUE

The poetic city of Hue lies in the Central part of Vietnam, once a flourishing royal capital. Thus, tourism sites in Hue connects to major events in the past, most of them stood still from the Nguyen Dynasty (19th century) highlighted by the Imperial Citadel Complex. As a center of Vietnamese royalty, Hue is also known for its imperial cuisine and cultural art which draw much of tourist's attention. Besides, there are many more interesting things to do in Hue like cycling around the picturesque lush countryside or going on a boat cruise on the placid Huong River admire the Hue's landmarks or immersing in the crystal clear water of Lang Co beach.



DA NANG

Da Nang marks its fame with tons of interesting tourist attractions and stunning beaches of white soft sand and turquoise water. Tourists coming to Da Nang are enchanted with its beautiful Marble Mountain, the amazing beach of My Khe, the remarkable Golden Bridge and recreational complex on Ba Na Hills as well as the picturesque landscape and diverse wildlife in Son Tra Peninsula. YANGON

Yangon City is being known as the former capital city as well as the largest city of the land of Myanmar. The most remarkable monument that must be mentioned is the shiny gold-covered majestic Shwedagon Pagoda, which also features distinctive history stories and stunning architectural details. Yangon has a lot to offer from the authentic local-vibe of the circular train ride, the imprints of the British colonial era to the fascinating nightlife with street food and bars.

BAGAN

The ancient city of Bagan possesses over 3000 religious sites of temples and pagodas making it one of the most unique sites in the world. The pristine beauty of the red-brick stupas ranging on the wide plain becomes more magnificent at the break of dawn from the bird's eye view of the hot air balloon. Not to mention, rumor said that the sunset in Bagan is also something to die for. Apart from temple hopping, you can check out the lacquerware workshops where to preserve the traditional handicraft for nearly two centuries.



INLE LAKE

Nested right behind the little old village of Nyaungshwe lies the prominent Inle Lake where you can witness the lively life of the Burmese villagers and fishermen. On the surface of the lake, surrounding the wooden houses on stilts are the lovely, greenery floating gardens where the local grow plants and vegetables for basic needs. A little far beyond the lake, tourists can catch a glimpse of one-legged rowing fishermen nesting for a big catch of the day. Inle Lake is also well – known for the traditional handicrafts of lotus silk weaving, cheroot (Burmese cigar) rolling and silver making offering a great chance for tourists to experience the procedures.



MANDALAY

Mandalay is noticed as a cultural capital and one of the most wonderful cities to visit in Myanmar. The region owns marvelous sites from the magnificent teak monastery of Shwenandaw to the world's largest book - Kuthodaw Pagoda as well as many other traditional cottons, silk hand-weaving, stone carving workshops. From Mandalay, it is easy to access to the one-and-only U Bein Bridge where to contemplate the breathtaking sunset or hop on a ride to get to nearby areas with more superb monuments in Mingun, Ava, and Sagaing.



NGAPALI

Blessed with turquoise blue water, white soft sand and dreamy palm line, Ngapali Beach is deserved to be called the Maldives of Southeast Asia. In Ngapali, you can experience almost every beach-activities, for instance, snorkeling, kayaking or scuba diving. Further to the southern part of Ngapali, it is possible to ride on the bike to find a more tranquil, untouched and unaffected from the modern development coastal line and discover fresh mouth-watering seafood.



KALAW

Kalaw - a beautiful hill town at the height of 1,320 meters owns a pleasant climate and charming colonial buildings. The area is also an ideal place to get to know the traditional rural ambiance from the local markets and indigenous tribes. Green Hill Elephant Camp - a sanctuary for the old-age elephants is worth a visit either where you can actually join in to take care of their daily routines. LOIKAW

When traveling in Loikaw, tourists will have an opportunity to truly immerse yourself in the traditional customs of the minor ethnic tribes in Burma as well as the exotic hill scenery. It's time to take great photos of the villagers with unique practices such as blackening their teeth or piercing and wearing an excessively huge amount of bracelets around their arms and necks.

GOLDEN ROCK

Golden Rock is one of the most religiously significant sites in Myanmar. The magical sight of Golden Rock will go far beyond your imagination as well as expectation due to the fact that it looks like being enchanted by the Buddha's hands. Going off the beaten path, on foot, will be a more exhilarating adventure and along the way, should you have the time to wander around the village, you can find the path to a small waterfall as well as a local amusement park called Smile World.

HPA-AN

Looking for a fresh natural expedition, come to Hpa-an to wash away all of your worries and be one with mother nature. You can climb on the top of Mt. Zwegabin to catch the panoramic view over the placid surroundings, explore the cave of Sadan where features a great number of Buddha images or trek through the mesmerizing rice paddies to soak up in the tranquil ambience. What is more, Hpa – an also offers you a great chance to get to know the history and unique culture of Karen people.

MERGUI ARCHIPELAGO

Going off the map on the Andaman Sea to the less-known place to the world called the Mergui Archipelago, it is better yet the most desired heaven in the world with absolutely no internet connection. The Mergui Archipelago is precisely the meant-to-be place for dauntless adventurers to dive in the blue sapphire water and watch the marine life of rays and coral reefs. If lucky enough, it is possible to catch the view of the natural divers - the Moken "sea gypsy" in the isolated zone and left behind by the rush of modernity. MONYWA

TAUNGGYI

Taunggyi is well-known for the grandest annually festive atmosphere of Fire Balloon - a festival indicating the end of the rainy season with fireworks and numerous hot air balloons in different eye-catching shapes and designs. In addition, it possesses diverse ethnic culture of Shan, Pa O and Intha people as well as many important places for worshipping. From Taunggyi, you can also take a short drive to reach to the outstanding pagoda complex of Kakku where 2000 ancient stupas stand closely together in a vast square field.



PUTAO

Up in the northern part, far away to the Himalayan region of Myanmar rests the alluring green valley under the snow-capped peaks - Putao. The land is the perfect match for true thrill – seekers to conquer serious trekking, mountaineering, and whitewater rafting. Putao still keeps its untouched paradisiacal charms with dramatic scenery of flora and fauna, evergreen mountain ranges and indigenous, diverse ethnic minority tribes.



MRAUK U

Travel back into the ancient time with the hidden city of Mrauk U through temples to temples on a lush green landscape. Mrauk U enchants every tourist with its dark, brick-built, bell-shaped temples or the colorful mosaic-like pagodas, as well as natural fresh-air valley walk paths. In Mrauk U, it's a good chance to learn the histories and legends told by the locals - from whom true stories are unfolded.



MINDAT (MOTORBIKE TOUR, TREKKING)
